Worcester County remains #3 in the state for overdose deaths among residents, as the latest opioid statistics from MA.gov show. Hard times won't stop us from doing our work, and clearly they won't stop our amazing giving community from continuing to find unique ways to come together - safely, to help so many who truly need our services! CELEBRATING & ADVOCATING VIRTUALLY



According to the latest DPH information there were 1.517 opioidrelated overdose deaths from Jan.-Nov. of 2020 (up 2.2%, from the same period last year). In an effort to raise awareness to statistics like these, we come together each fall with the community to participate in local Recovery Month (September) events. We team up with organizations that help spread a message of hope and healing to those in our community who suffer from the effects of Substance Use Disorder. Virtual meetings took the place of most events this year, but we still participated- safely! We kicked it off with the Worcester International Overdose Awareness Day Virtual Candlelight Vigil on Aug. 31, 2020 to honor the lives of those we have lost to overdose. On Sept. 30th we virtually attended the Spectrum Health Systems Peer Support Centers 1st Annual Celebrating Connections in Recovery Virtual Walk & Rally. Lastly on Dec. 21, 2020 we took part in the City of Worcester Health & Human Services, and Homeless Outreach & Advocacy Project (HOAP) 30th Anniversary of Homeless Persons Memorial Day and Longest Night Vigil. To help bring awareness and hope to our homeless community, to which many of our residents once belonged. We are grateful to be a part of such a brave and loving community. One where COVID may stop us from getting together, but will not stop us from speaking out and speaking up for those who need a voice. #WeAreJI
